The boy was noticed by Drv B Hanson of the RASC who rescues him and pulls Sirvic Franzere into the Dingo scout car (F206082).

A final pull into the seat of the boys trousers and he is safe inside the scout car.

Drv Hanson returns the truant to his mother.
